

AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE MUHLENBERG COUNTY FISCAL COURT BEGAN AND HELD AT THE MUHLENBERG COUNTY COURTHOUSE, LOCATED IN GREENVILLE, KENTUCKY ON SEPTEMBER 14, 2017 AT 4:00 P.M. WITH THE HONORABLE RICK NEWMAN COUNTY JUDGE/EXECUTIVE PRESIDING. THE FOLLOWING MAGISTRATES WERE PRESENT COZY CHAPPELL, DARRIN BENTON, TOMMY WATKINS, BRENT SHERROD AND JOE GLENN MITCHELL. NONE WERE ABSENT.

Minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed. Motion was made by Joe Mitchell, second by Tommy Watkins and by the unanimous vote of the court to approve the minutes as presented.

Public participation – none

Sheriff's fees for August were presented in the amount of \$19,057.70. Motion was made by Joe Mitchell, second by Darrin Benton to accept the Sheriff's fees, subject to state audit.

Clerk's fees for August were presented in the amount of \$65,842.47. Motion was made by Darrin Benton, second by Brent Sherrod and by the unanimous vote of the court to accept the Clerk's fees, subject to state audit.

Resolution # 14-09-17, pertaining to the lease of trucks through KACO Leasing Trust, was presented for the courts approval.

A Resolution adopting extension of two roads into the county road plan was presented. Myers Lane .022 miles to a total length of .089 miles and extend Old Greenville Road .106 miles to total a length of .411 miles.

Discussion was had by the court on creating a revenue stream for E-911. Since so many people have dropped their landlines, which had a fee attached, the court is considering placing a fee on water meters.

New Cypress Ballpark property was discussed again. Motion was made by Brent Sherrod, second by Tommy Watkins and by the unanimous vote of the court to declare the acreage surplus property.

Motion was made by Brent Sherrod, second by Cozy Chappell and by the unanimous vote of the court to advertise for bids on the sale of the New Cypress Ballpark property.

Motion was made by Darrin Benton, second by Joe Mitchell and by the unanimous vote of the court to move the Truck Lease Public Hearing to September 28th at 3:15 prior to the regular meeting.

Motion was made by Tommy Watkins, second by Brent Sherrod and by the unanimous vote of the court to move the Tax Rate Hearing to September 28th at 3:30 p.m.

Motion was made by Tommy Watkins, second by Joe Mitchell and by the unanimous vote of the court to move the Tangible Tax Rate Hearing to September 28th at 3:30 also.

Dates for the October court meeting were discussed. No firm dates were set the court will pick up this matter at the 28th meeting.
